



Dear parents

A pupil in Year 6 has tested positive for Coronavirus.

Following these results, we have worked closely with Public Health to identify any pupils and staff who need to isolate. Following this track and trace process, we have to do the following:

- Year 6 pupils need to isolate until midnight on Saturday 10th July.
- Pupils can return to school on Monday 12th July at usual times
- Year 6 pupils must stay at home.
- Any siblings and other family members can still go out and attend school.
- Year 6 pupils **can't come on to the school grounds** when bringing their siblings to school in the mornings or collecting at home time. Please call school to discuss alternative arrangements if needed.

Year 6 pupils will only need to get a test if they start showing symptoms themselves. If your child shows COVID symptoms, they will need to get a test and the rest of the household will need to isolate until the test results return.
