One-way system and staggered start/end times

KS1 and KS2 families

Your collection time is 3:10pm. Please enter through the Pinfold Street gates, collect your children and leave through the Moxley Road gate.

KS2 children only

Your collection time is 3:20pm. Please enter through the Pinfold Street gates, collect your children and leave through the Moxley Road gate.



Attendance

Attendance is compulsory for all children from Monday 8th March and your child is expected to attend school. Please ensure that you send your child to school in full school uniform from Tuesday 9th. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact us and we will try our best to help.

Before and After School Provision - Scallywags

Before and after school care will continue from Monday 8th March. If your child was attending Scallywags in December, this will continue when the children return to school.

Next week's parent meetings

Parents meeting slots will take place next week; a huge thank you to all of the families who have signed up for a slot via Google Forms.

As the meetings will be taking place on Google Meet, it is important that you **do not join your meeting early**. Only join when your device clock shows the exact time for your meeting to start.

For example, if your meeting is at 5:10 please do not try to join your meeting at 5:09. You will have to wait until exactly 5:10.

During the Parents Evening days, no work will be set on Seesaw as teachers will be attending appointments. Both of these days will be screen free days and we are encouraging activities such as arts, crafts, PE and activities that promote health and well-being.

Class Google Meets

During next week, your child's class Google Meet session will only take place on **Monday** and **Friday**. On the other days, teachers will be in the parent meetings.

Laptops and Devices

If you have a school laptop or iPad, please **do not** return them to school during week beginning Monday 8th March, keep using them at home. More details about how to return your device safely will be shared soon.

Parking restrictions come into place on Monday 8th March on Pinfold Street Extension. We have been informed that fines will be issued should you park on the street outside school inbetween 8:00am and 9:30am and 2:30pm and 4pm.
