Meet Inference Iggy – the dog who helps us learn how to infer a character's feelings and motives.

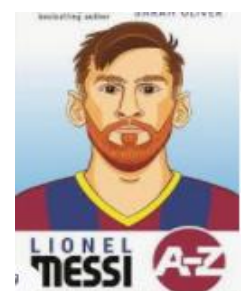
### Share your passion for reading!
