

Dear parents/carers,

Reminder that NATIONAL RESTRICTIONS are STILL IN PLACE. You cannot visit other homes including family members. Let's work together in the hope to see our families at Christmas.



In order to ensure the safety of everyone, we would like to ask our families to continue to support school.

- **If anyone in the household starts to show symptoms, everyone in the household should isolate until the test results come back.**
- **If you or your child phone school and leave a message to explain that someone is unwell, please give as much detail as possible.**
- **If you have no phone credit, but have wifi/internet data, you can email school on info@pinfold-st.walsall.sch.uk to inform us of the absence or request a call back.**

Current advice from Public Health is that any pupil with sickness or diarrhoea will have to stay off school for 72 hours from the last episode.

In school, we need to keep the classrooms well ventilated, so most of the windows are open at least an inch wide. The heating is on, however if your child feels particularly cold, here are a few things that will help:

- Wear a vest or t-shirt under the uniform top
- Wear a plain fleece that is black, navy or grey (no hood) which can be kept on in class.
