Currently Walsall is in Tier 2 high alert. This means that:

Pupils have told us today that they have been to Halloween parties or had sleep overs at other homes. This is breaking the law and putting us all at risk.

If we want to get back to some form of normality, we need to work together and follow the guidelines that are in place to keep us all safe.

As you will be aware from Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> November new national restrictions come into force. Schools will remain open. In order to ensure the safety of everyone, we would like to ask our families to continue to support school. We need parents to:

- **Keep 2m away** from other families
- Wear a face covering
- **Email or phone school to discuss concerns**, teachers have been told not to have chats with parents on the playground.
- Keep your children with you when leaving the school
- **Keep behind** the white lines
- Arrive on time, not early and queue,
