

## Dear parents

A pupil in Y1 has tested positive for Coronavirus.

Following these results, we have worked closely with Public Health to identify any pupils and staff who need to isolate. Following this track and trace process, we have to do the following:

- Y1 need to isolate until Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> December. Pupils can return to school on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> December.
- Year 1 pupils must stay at home.
- Any siblings and other family members can still go out and attend school.
- Y1 pupils **can't come on to the school grounds** when bringing their siblings to school in the mornings or collecting at home time. Please call school to discuss alternative arrangements.

Y1 pupils will only need to get a test if they start showing symptoms themselves. If a Y1 pupil shows symptoms, they will need to get a test and the rest of the household will need to isolate until the test results return. YOU MUST INFORM SCHOOL IMMEDIATELY IF THIS HAPPENS.

If you need any advice at all, please contact school.

Each day the Y1 teachers will upload learning tasks to Seesaw for the day and provide a recommended timetable to follow. Please make sure your child completes as much of the learning as possible. Pupils can also access Numbots, Education City and any other learning programmes.

All of Y1 can return to school on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> December. We will keep you updated with any further information.
